The ATI TEAS will be given twice during the 2017-18 academic year.
Once in Nov. 2017 & once in Feb. 2018. The highest score will be used.

The 2017-2018 Fall ATI TEAS Test Schedule will be published on October 31st, 2017. Students can reserve a Nov. 2017 test date beginning on Monday, November 6th, 2017. The 2017-18 Spring ATI TEAS Test Schedule will be published on February 5th, 2018. Students can reserve a test date for Feb. 2018 beginning on Monday, Feb. 12th, 2018.

Before taking the ATI TEAS Test, students must first:

1. Review the BCC Nursing Admissions Checklist to ensure they meet criteria.
2. Create a “TEAS Student Account” at www.atitesting.com and, on the day of the test, **know their username and password.**
3. See Tommy Rains in Building 8, Room 4, on or after the dates mentioned above to **complete & sign the BCC ATI TEAS Registration Form** to reserve a testing date.

ON THE DAY OF THE TEST students should report to **Bldg. 8, Room 4**, with a **PICTURE ID** & **Credit or Debit Card** to pay the **testing fee** online.
