



## **Graduation 2021!**

### **Attention Students: If You Plan to Graduate in 2020, Now is the Time to Apply.**

The Registrar's Office is now accepting applications for Fall 2020, Spring 2021, and potential Summer 2021 graduates.

Graduation Application Packets are available in the Registrar's Office located in Building 2 and online at [www.bladencce.edu](http://www.bladencce.edu). Please read through the Graduation Application Packet and consult with our staff if you have any questions about the process for becoming a candidate for graduation.

#### **Your application packet will consist of:**

- Graduation Application
- Graduation Eligibility Information Sheet
- Question and Answer Form (Graduation Q's and A's)
- Alumni form

Do not pay for graduation until you have consulted with your faculty advisor and have reviewed your educational plan. The graduation fee is non-refundable.

#### **Application Process:**

1. Pick up your Graduation Application Packet at the Registrar's Office from Building 2 or print it from [www.bladencce.edu](http://www.bladencce.edu).
2. Read the information in the Graduation Application Packet.
3. Meet with your faculty advisor to review your educational plan.
4. Pay the graduation fee of \$25.00 (for diplomas/degrees) at the Cashier's Office located in the Essie Williams Building (building 10) or via phone at 910.879.5507.
5. Turn in your Graduation Application to the Registrar's Office along with your paid receipt from the Cashier's Office.

#### **Deadlines for Applying:**

To ensure timely feedback from the Registrar about your candidacy for graduation, to be included in the graduation mailing list for 2020, applications for Graduation should be returned to the Registrar's Office by **Wednesday, November 25, 2020**.

This deadline applies to diplomas/degrees. Certificate completers may fill out the Application for Certificate(s) at any time during the semester. Certificates are printed at the end of each semester at no cost to the student.

**\*The \$25 graduation fee is also required for a certificate earning student planning to participate in the graduation ceremony.**
